Dress code...

As a Christian camp we want to display Biblical ideals in all that we do. In order to be distinguished as a Bible camp we feel that our dress standards should be higher than a secular camp. We hold to the biblical teaching that men and women should be distinguished in their appearance and thus we require the following dress code...

Female campers and staff...

No pants of any kind shall be worn while at camp. This includes Capri pants. All shirts should be modest and not be low cut. No mid riff shirts or shirts that have inappropriate printings on them. For sports, you may wear culottes and long athletic shorts that are loose fitting and go down past your knee caps during activities. Please use discretion as you pack, to make sure that clothes are not see through or tight fitting in a way that could be immodest. It is best to wear dark colored shirts during sports and activities. You may wear your clothes or a long robe to and from pool area. Sleeveless shirts may be worn as long as they are not revealing. We reserve the right to ask you to change clothes if we deem necessary. Please help us out by conforming to these simple codes.

Male campers and staff...

You must wear a shirt at all times. Long shorts that go down past your knees may be worn during sports. Long pants must be worn to all services. Watch out for inappropriate printings and you may also wear a long robe or clothes to and from the pool.

These simple rules will help us keep our standard high.

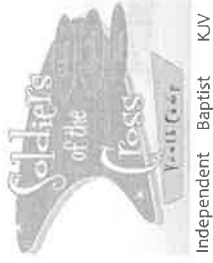

This year we are offering two camp packages for the same week.

Package 1:
